Career & Self-Development

Demonstrate the awareness, attitude, knowledge, and skills required to equitably engage and include people from different local and global cultures. Engage in anti-racist practices that actively challenge the systems, structures, and policies of racism.

Leadership

Recognize and capitalize on personal and team strengths to achieve organizational goals.

Professionalism

Knowing work environments differ greatly, understand and demonstrateeffective work habits, and act in the interest of the larger community and workplace.

Teamwork

Build and maintain collaborative relationships to work effectively toward common goals, while appreciating diverse viewpoints and shared responsibilities.




Year 1 Career Map

Meet with Office of Academic Advising to explore academic disciplines Complete Career Assessment: FOCUS Maintain a schedule and set goals



Update your résumé Develop a professional wardrobe


