TRANSFERRING CREDIT

Students can transfer up to 75 credits from another accredited college or university. Our experiential Portfolio Assessment service can also help you earn credits for on-the-job experience and training programs.

CAREER SERVICES

In addition to job search assistance, Internship programs are available for students who are changing careers. Supervised and facilitated by the ACCELERATED Internship Coordinator, these programs offer valuable real-world experience. Many students are frequently hired upon completion of their internship.

STUDY TOURS

ACCELERATED students can earn six credits by traveling abroad or within the U.S. on study tours. Foreign tours to London, Paris, Russia, Italy, or Ireland last 7 to 10 days. They provide a valuable opportunity to socialize with other adult students and see the world—while earning college credits at the same time. Our local and regional study tours include interdisciplinary classes that introduce you to the theater and arts in the Philadelphia, New York, and Washington, D.C. areas.
