TWO GREAT FINANCIAL AID OPPORTUNITIES

PHMC GRANT

Student support funds are available through a Public Health Management Corporation (PHMC) grant for those who are:

- Currently enrolled (or planning to enroll) in one of the degree programs listed above
- A Pennsylvania resident
- Currently employed at an early childcare center that is licensed by OCDEL and located in Philadelphia or Delaware County

To apply:

1. Submit your Professional Development Registry ID number. (If you do not have an ID number, you can register for one [HERE](#).)
2. Complete the FAFSA application online and enter Chestnut Hill College's Federal Code 003245. By filing the FAFSA, you will be applying for any federal or state aid, including Pell, PHEAA, SEOG and federal loans. (For assistance: customer service 1-800-433-3243.)
3. [Apply for a T.E.A.C.H. Scholarship](#) or provide evidence that your application was denied or that you are ineligible. To be eligible for T.E.A.C.H. you must:
 - Be registered for the current session
 - Work a minimum of 25-30 hours/week directly with children in a DHS-certified child care program
 - Earn \$19.00 or less per hour (\$25.00 or less an hour for directors)
 - Be interested in pursuing coursework at a participating college (at least 9 credits/year) toward a degree in ECE
 - Have at least 55 transferable credits towards a degree in ECE (or equivalent)

Once all non-loan aid/scholarship opportunities have been exhausted, PHMC student support funds may be awarded. It is PHMC's intent that students be required to pay as little out-of-pocket as possible to pursue their bachelor's degree.

MCNULTY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

To be eligible for this scholarship, you must:

- Be currently enrolled (or planning to enroll) in one of the degree programs listed above
- Work a minimum of 20 hours per week directly with children within an approved child care facility identified by Public Health Management Corporation (PHMC) or a facility that has more than 50% of children enrolled who receive subsidized care
- Submit a letter from employer verifying employment status including percentage of enrolled children receiving subsidized care
- NOT be eligible for T.E.A.C.H. or PHMC scholarship funding

To apply:

Complete the FAFSA application online. CHC's Federal Code is 003245. By filing the FAFSA, you will be applying for any federal or state aid, including Pell, PHEAA, SEOG and federal loans. If you require additional assistance, call customer service at 1-800-4FED-AID (1-800-433-3243.)

Please note: Priority consideration will be given to candidates with an estimated family contribution (EFC) of \$10,000 or below.
