**12/16/2022:** Last day to register for 5 month SPRING ONLY Nelnet plan

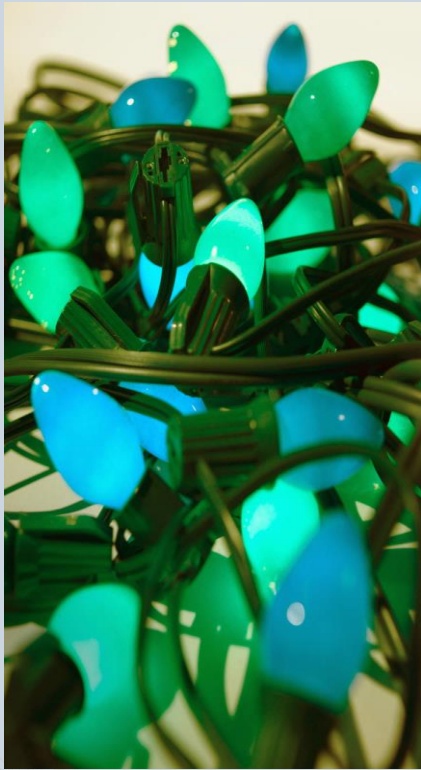
**1/02/2023:** Spring payment or registration in an approved payment plan is due

## Information Regarding Fall PA State Grant

## Tips for Pre-Spring Semester Prep

- If you are enrolled in an **Annual Nelnet payment plan**, please check that your spring bill matches the estimate provided when your plan was set up. If you notice a discrepancy, have made changes to your residency status, or have been notified of changes to your aid, please contact Student Accounts
- Spring Disbursement Dates will be included in an upcoming Newsletter. If you anticipate a credit, please double check that your address on MYCHC is correct to prevent delays in receiving your refund.
- If you plan to change your campus resident status between the fall and spring, please be sure to contact Residence Life for confirmation prior to reaching out about your billing statement.
- If you would like to register for a **SPRING ONLY Nelnet plan** (and do not have an active Annual plan), please sign up prior to the deadlines listed on page 1.
