APPLICATION DEADLINE

YEAR I: The Psy.D. program at Chestnut Hill College accepts applicants for the fall semester only. The program accepts applicants to Year 1 on a rolling admissions basis until the entering class is filled. Application by January 15th is strongly encouraged.

YEAR II: The application deadline for Year II is **January 15th**. All applicants whose applications are completed by January 15th will be notified of their status by April 15th. Incomplete application packets cannot be considered. It is recommended that the applicant submit all materials except for the test scores as a complete packet. If that is not possible, the application form with fee must accompany the first materials submitted.
