## Fall Semester Billing

Bills for the Fall semester are available on MyCHC as of July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022.

Your bill can be accessed online only. A paper bill will not be sent automatically.

Payment for the Fall semester, or registration in an approved payment plan, is due by August 1st, 2022.

If you are registered in an annual Nelnet plan, please confirm that your plan matches your outstanding balance once your official bill is available. Prior to Fall billing, annual plans are based on an estimated amount and may need to be adjusted to match the final bill. If your plan requires changes, contact [Accounts@chc.edu](mailto:Accounts@chc.edu).

If you are registered in a "Fall Only" payment plan, a new plan will have to be set up for the Spring semester.

Please check that your anticipated aid for spring is listed on the account. If it is not, please contact [Finaid@chc.edu](mailto:Finaid@chc.edu).

If you have questions or concerns about your bill, please reach out to us as soon as possible.

## What is a Bookstore Voucher?

If you have financial aid funding for the fall that exceeds your cost of tuition, your account will reflect a credit (a negative number listed where the balance would be). If you see a credit on your account, you are eligible to use that funding at the CHC bookstore prior to aid disbursement to pay for text books and other materials. When purchasing books online, simply select "pay with financial aid" during checkout. If you are purchasing your books on campus, the store can confirm your credit using your student ID#. Please be aware that there are other kinds of bookstore vouchers offered at CHC that do not stem from surplus aid funding. If you are not sure what kind of voucher you qualify for, please reach out to Student Accounts at [Studentaccounts@chc.edu](mailto:Studentaccounts@chc.edu).

## SFS Move-In Checklist

Living on campus in the fall? Please make sure to complete the requirements listed below prior to move-in weekend to ensure a seamless transition into the fall semester. Please note that students who are not cleared by SFS will be unable to move-in at their scheduled time.

1. Have you submitted you FAFSA and accepted your financial aid?
2. Have you completed any financial aid verification requirements? (if applicable)
3. Have you submitted payment for any outstanding fall balance, or registered in a Nelnet payment plan?
4. Have you confirmed that your Nelnet plan is set for the right amount with Student Accounts?
5. If you do not wish to utilize a payment plan and have a remaining balance, have you applied for additional aid such as a Parent PLUS or alternative loan?

## 2022-2023 Nelnet Payment Plan Information

CHC offers a number of payment plan options for all student divisions through the Nelnet service. If you are interested in starting a payment plan, check the information below to see what plans are available to you. Please note that Nelnet requires a \$75 registration fee per plan. When you have selected your plan, you can sign up with Nelnet directly by clicking on the link below. The website will prompt you to enter your estimated balance, which can be found on MyCHC. If you are unsure of the correct balance to enter, please contact Student Accounts at [Studentaccounts@chc.edu](mailto:Studentaccounts@chc.edu).

### Traditional Undergraduate Students:

CHC offers payment plans through Nelnet. For traditional daytime Undergraduates, we recommend registration in an annual plan, which will allow you to pay for the full school year balance (fall and spring together) throughout the year. Annual plan registration dates are as follows:

Last day to enroll online	Required down payment	Number of payments
August 11	10%	9
September 9	20%	8

### Graduate and Accelerated (AADP) Students

Graduate and AADP students are encouraged to sign up for a single semester (fall only) payment plan due to the flexibility in graduate and AADP registration from semester to semester. Students who select this option will have to set up a new plan for the spring semester when the fall plan is complete.

### Do You Have Questions About Your Federal Student Aid?

If you use federal student loans and grants (Subsidized, Unsubsidized, PELL, PHEAA etc.), The National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) is a great tool to monitor your loan amounts, services, and limits. The NSLDS site states:

“The National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) is the U.S. Department of Education's (ED's) central database for student aid. NSLDS receives data from schools, guaranty agencies, the Direct Loan program, and other Department of ED programs. NSLDS Student Access provides a centralized, integrated view of Title IV loans and grants so that recipients of Title IV Aid can access and inquire about their Title IV loans and/or grant data.”

NSLDS gives you 24 hour access to your student loan information and is available around the clock to answer questions you may have regarding your federal aid. You can visit NSLDS at:

### Do You Need a FERPA Waiver?

FERPA is the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act. Under this law, SFS cannot discuss student financial information with any party other than the student. In order for SFS to discuss your account balances and aid with a parent or guardian, we must have a FERPA waiver on file listing approved family members by name.
