The Tichenor-Greer Scholars Program recognizes talented students who are interested in pursuing majors and careers in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) and who are from populations underrepresented in STEM fields.

Each year, a cohort of up to 20 first-year students is selected for the program, all of whom intend to enroll in one of CHC's STEM majors.

Through a generous gift from Patricia Tichenor-Greer, M.A., Ph.D., '62 and Carl Greer, Ph.D., Psy.D., selected students are awarded a scholarship, a book stipend, and a cadre of intensive support services.

# ACADEMIC SUPPORT

Tichenor-Greer Scholars receive the additional support systems, early interventions, and services needed to successfully complete a challenging STEM degree, including:

- Academic Support - Each scholar will receive tutoring and advising to support his or her academic and career goals, assistance in developing a personal success plan, and workshops to build skills to enhance achievement.
- Extracurricular Involvement - Each scholar will be assigned a mentor, involved in STEM-related trips and activities, and encouraged to complete summer research and/or internships in his or her chosen field.
- Service Learning - Each scholar will participate in service projects in the local community — many focusing on encouraging the next generation of students to pursue STEM degrees.

# SCHOLARSHIP SUPPORT

Students receive a scholarship of \$5,000 per year for four years as long as they meet program requirements, some of which include:

- Remaining a Chestnut Hill College student in good standing in one of the STEM majors offered.
- Maintaining a grade point average of at least 2.5.
- Participating in all required program activities, including community service.
