WHY A MASTER'S IN CYBERSECURITY AT CHESTNUT HILL COLLEGE?

The Chestnut Hill College Master of Science (M.S.) in Cybersecurity is a 100% ONLINE, 30-36 credit program with highly competitive tuition and strong job prospects in a lucrative field. The program's online design allows professionals to complete this Master's degree in 20-24 months. Students take two 8-week accelerated courses consecutively in the fall, summer, and spring semesters. All courses are designed and taught by subject matter experts with diverse experience in the cybersecurity field, and are cybersecurity-related; the only exception are general computer science/information technology courses required for students without a technology background.
