This program is designed for:

- Educators who already have a PA teaching certification and want to add Special Education certification.
- Those who completed a PK-8 or 7-12 Special Education preparation program but did not achieve certification.

Is student teaching required?

No, this program does not include a student teaching component.

How long does the program take to complete?

The program can be completed in 2 to 3 semesters, depending on whether you are studying full-time or part-time.

ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

 Hold a current PA teaching certificate from the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE)

OR

- Have previously completed a Teacher Preparation Program, including student teaching.
 - Official transcripts required from all colleges and universities attended
 - Letters of recommendation required from academic and professional sources
 - Resume or curriculum vitae
 - Professional essay (description in online application)

*Once all materials are received, the Admissions committee will review the applications and invite qualified applicants for an interview.
