M.Ed. and/or Teacher Certification

For post-baccalaureate students preparing to teach, or current teachers with PA intern or emergency certification. Hybrid format in Fall/Spring; online in Summer. \$675/credit.*

- Early Childhood (PK-4), 33 credits
- Special Education (PK-12), 33 credits
- Dual Special Education and Early Childhood or Secondary Education, 36 credits
- Secondary Education (7-12), 30 credits.

 - Biology or Chemistry

M.Ed. in Educational Studies

For practicing educators who want to study for a master's degree and do not need certification. Take 30 credits at \$675 per credit (2025-2026)*--Five core courses, five education elective courses. Hybrid format in Fall/Spring; online in Summer.

M.Ed. in Educational Leadership and/or Principal Certification

Starting in Fall 2025, 100% online coursework with embedded practicum projects and an internship at the candidate's school. Certification program completed in one year--18 credits at \$500/credit. M.Ed. achieved with 12 additional credits.*
